AISLS POLICY ON MEMBERSHIP OF THE AISLS BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND APPLYING FOR AND HOLDING AN AISLS FELLOWSHIP

- 1. Any member of the AISLS board of directors who wishes to apply for an AISLS fellowship must resign from the AISLS board of directors before the fellowship deadline.
- 2. If the applicant was an institutional representative, and he/she does not receive a fellowship, his/her institution may reappoint him/her to the board at any time after the selection process has been completed.
- 3. If the applicant was an elected member, and he/she does not receive a fellowship, he/she is eligible to run for election to the board at the next election.
- 4. All holders of AISLS fellowships must wait six months after the completion of their fellowship tenure before being eligible for appointment or election to the board.
