

AISLS POLICY ON MEMBERSHIP OF THE AISLS BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND APPLYING FOR AND HOLDING AN AISLS FELLOWSHIP

1. Any member of the AISLS board of directors who wishes to apply for an AISLS fellowship must resign from the AISLS board of directors before the fellowship deadline.
2. If the applicant was an institutional representative, and he/she does not receive a fellowship, his/her institution may reappoint him/her to the board at any time after the selection process has been completed.
3. If the applicant was an elected member, and he/she does not receive a fellowship, he/she is eligible to run for election to the board at the next election.
4. All holders of AISLS fellowships must wait six months after the completion of their fellowship tenure before being eligible for appointment or election to the board.
